If you are coming from Interstate 8, going East:

Turn Left, or North onto Sunrise Hwy. exit, a.k.a. (Co. Hwy. S-1). The Burnt Rancheria Campground is located on the Right side past Mile Markers #26 and about 1/8 mile South of the Laguna Mtn. General Store, also Campsite Entrance is next to the Pine House Café and Tavern

From Ramona and Julian; Go South, on Hwy. 79, onto Sunrise Hwy (S-1). Go about 5 ½ miles to the Campground, on the left side before just past the Laguna Mtn. General Store which will be on the right, you will see the Pine House Café and Tavern on the left.
